I. STATUS

- A. <u>Meetings:</u> The Recreational Advisory Panel met on Jan. 18, 2022. The Groundfish Committee met on Jan. 20, 2022. All meetings were held by webinar.
- B. <u>Amendment 23/Groundfish Monitoring:</u> An announcement of availability of amendment and request for comments published in the Federal Register on Jan. 14, 2022. The deadline for comments is Mar. 15, 2022.
- C. <u>Framework Adjustment 63 (specifications and management measures):</u> The Council took final action on Dec. 8, 2021. Staff is preparing the document for submission to GARFO.
- D. <u>Recreational Measures for 2022:</u> Staff will provide an overview of possible recreational management measures for fishing year 2022 for Gulf of Maine cod and Gulf of Maine haddock. The Council will make recommendations to GARFO at the February 2022 Council meeting.
- E. 2021 Atlantic Cod Stock Structure Workshops The 2021 Atlantic Cod Stock Structure Workshops were supported by the New England Fishery Management Council (NEFMC) and NOAA's Northeast Fisheries Science Center (NEFSC) and facilitated by NH Sea Grant. The workshops presented a two-pronged approach developed to incorporate new stock definitions into existing science and management structures.
