I. STATUS

- A. Meetings: The Groundfish Committee met on June. 14, 2022. The Recreational Advisory Panel met on Jun. 1, 2022. The Groundfish Advisory Panel met on Jun. 2, 2022. The Groundfish Plan Development Team (PDT) met on May 18 and Jun. 21, 2022. Meetings were by webinar.
- B. <u>Amendment 23/Groundfish Monitoring:</u> GARFO sent a decision letter to the Council on Apr. 12, 2022, approving the amendment. The final rule is pending.
- C. <u>Framework Adjustment 63 (specifications and management measures):</u> The proposed rule was published on Apr. 20, 2022. The comment period closed on May 5, 2022. The final rule is pending.
- D. <u>Framework Adjustment 65 (specifications and management measures for 2023 2024)</u>: The Council initiated this action in April 2022.
- E. <u>Atlantic Cod Management:</u> An update from the Atlantic Cod Research Track working group and the Committee's work on the transition plan (from 2 management units to up to 5) is anticipated with a focus on the white paper on Georges Bank cod allocation to the recreational fishery.
