Meetings: On August 19, the SSC met via a hybrid meeting in Boston, MA to: 1) recommend overfishing limits and acceptable biological catches for northern and southern monkfish and the skate complex, 2) make recommendations to the Scallop PDT for developing specifications to present to the SSC in October that consider the outcomes of the 2025 Atlantic Sea scallop research track assessment, and 3) review outcomes of the June 2025 inaugural meeting of the SSC Social Sciences Subcommittee and provide input on the Subcommittee's workplan.
