I. STATUS

SSC Meetings:

- October 13, 2021, webinar: The SSC received information from the 2020 management track assessment for scallops and from the Scallop PDT. Based on this information, the SSC developed OFL and ABC recommendations for the scallop fishery for fishing years 2022 and 2023 (default).
- October 25, 2021, webinar: The SSC received information from the 2020 management track assessments for Georges Bank (GB) and Gulf of Maine (GOM) haddock stocks, and GB and GOM cod stocks. Based on these assessment and information provided by the Groundfish PDT, the SSC developed OFL and ABC recommendations for GB and GOM haddock for fishing years 2022 2024; an ABC recommendation for GB cod and an OFL and ABC recommendations for GOM cod. The SSC also developed revised OFL and ABC recommendations for white hake for fishing year 2022 based on the information provided by the PDT.
