# NEW ENGLAND FISHERY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL Scientific and Statistical Committee (SSC)

- A Social Science subpanel of the SSC met on April 28, 2021 via webinar to review social and economic information and impact analyses in two previous Council actions with the purpose of making recommendations about how these types of analyses might be improved.
- The SSC met on May 11,2021 via webinar to receive a presentation, An Evaluation of Alternative Management Procedures for New England Groundfish, conducted by the Gulf of Maine Research Institute as part of a Council priority to consider modifying ABC control rules for Groundfish stocks.
- The SSC met on June 8, 2021to develop comments and recommendations for updating 2021-2025 Council research priorities. It also continued discussion of how to develop recommendations for modifying ABC control rules for Groundfish stocks.
