Agenda for April 16, 2013:

The Groundfish Oversight Committee will meet to discuss several issues related to the Northeast Multispecies Fishery Management Plan that will include:

- A report on the feasibility of and progress on data analyses that would inform the development of Amendment 18;
- A report from the Plan Development Team on eastern Georges Bank catch reporting, as well as a progress report on issues related to the relative stock size of GOM and GB haddock;
- May also discuss recent sector operations plan exemption requests and may discuss a request for an exploration of the impact of climate change on status determination criteria and catch advice;
- Other business will be discussed as necessary.

Agenda for April 17, 2013:

• The Committee will devote the entire day to considering area management options recommended by the Closed Area Technical Team. These measures are intended to replace existing year round and rolling groundfish closures. Following review at the April Council meeting, these groundfish area management options would be consolidated with the habitat management options being proposed by the Habitat Oversight Committee and included as alternatives in Omnibus Habitat Amendment 2.
