- The Observer Committee met on April 16, 2015 to: review and discuss updated information and analyses for the draft Environmental Assessment for NMFS-led omnibus amendment to establish provisions for industry-funded monitoring (IFM) across all Council-managed fisheries; and to consider additional options for industry-funded portside sampling and electronic monitoring (EM) in the Atlantic herring fishery, which would be implemented immediately in the IFM.
- The Observer Committee is scheduled to meet jointly with the Herring Committee on June 8, 2015 to review updated options/analyses for IFM in the Atlantic herring fishery, to be included in the Draft Environmental Assessment for the Omnibus IFM Amendment.
