Directions:

From the North: Take Route 95 South toward Peabody, MA. Take the Route 1 South exit towards Boston. Stay on Route 1 and take the Route 60 East Malden/Revere Exit. Off the exit go around the rotary and take your third exit onto Squire Road/Route 60 East. Stay straight, and at your next rotary take the second exit onto Route 60 East.
