SUBJECT: Purpose and agenda for meeting

Following the Status of the Ecosystem (SOE) presentation at the <u>Scientific and Statistical</u> <u>Committee conference call</u>, the <u>Ecosystem Based Fishery Management (EBFM) Committee</u> will meet by its own conference call at approximately 11:00 am on March 31, 2020. The meeting will run for approximately four hours and will not break for lunch (presumably you will be home and can eat lunch there if needed).

<u>Purpose</u>: The Committee should provide guidance on stakeholder profiles and deliverables to <u>Green Fin Studio (GFS)</u> as well as guidance to the EBFM Plan Development Team (PDT) on development of a more tangible worked example.

Following the Council's completion of an example Fishery Ecosystem Plan (eFEP), the Council convened a Management Strategy Evaluation Steering Committee (MSE SC) to advise the Council on how initiate the next step and to roll out the eFEP to the public. Their primary advice was to begin a strategic outreach program involving a professional science communicator and a more tangible worked example. The Council issued a request for proposals (RFP) and a team of Council staff and one MSE SC member chose GFS as our science communicator and we negotiated a statement of work, with outreach material deliverables expected to be presented at the Council's June 2020 meeting.

A timeline for development of a tangible worked example has not yet been developed (until we have an idea of what is needed and how long development would take). Public outreach workshops will follow the outreach material development process, but the format of workshops may need to be re-thought given current circumstances as they develop.

This EBFM Committee meeting is intended to provide more specific guidance on these tasks to both GFS and the PDT. The committee and PDT have both been surveyed for comments on an initial list of stakeholder profiles and on qualities and characteristics of a potential tangible worked example. These comments and related presentations will be shared during the EBFM Committee conference call.
