SUBJECT: Recreational Advisory Panel meeting on August 2, 2016

There will be a Groundfish Committee meeting at the DoubleTree by Hilton, South Portland, ME on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>August 2rd</u>, <u>starting at 10:00 AM</u>.

Purpose. The purpose of the Committee meeting is to 1) discuss the recreational management measures process and make recommendation to the Groundfish Committee for measures to include in Framework Adjustment 56 (FW 56); 2) discuss recommendations to the Groundfish Committee regarding 2017 Council priorities; and 3) discuss other business, as necessary.

Framework Adjustment 56
