SUBJECT: Recreational Advisory Panel meeting on Tuesday, November 14, 2017

Regulatory streamlining in response to recent Executive Orders

Several recent Executive Orders have been issued about streamlining current regulations, and NOAA is seeking public input on the efficiency and effectiveness of current regulations and whether they can be improved.

At the Meeting:

- The advisors will discuss whether there are any regulations in the Northeast Multispecies (groundfish) fishery management plan that could be eliminated, improved, or streamlined (Doc. 4).
- The advisors will develop recommendations to the Groundfish Committee.

After the Meeting:

Recommendations from the Committee will be summarized and provided to the Council.

Council:

The Council will meet on December 5-7 in Newport, RI. Recommendations by the Committee will be considered at this meeting.
