Transboundary Management Guidance Committee Report

To accept the US/CA 2019 quotas for Eastern Georges Bank cod (650mt), Eastern Georges Bank haddock (30,000mt), and Georges Bank yellowtail flounder (140mt), as carefully negotiated by the U.S. Transboundary Management Guidance Committee.
