SUBJECT:	Recreational Advisory Panel meeting on Friday, February 22, 2019

The Recreational Advisory Panel (RAP) will meet at the Hilton Garden Inn, Logan Airport, Boston, MA on Friday, February 22. starting at 10 am.

<u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of the RAP meeting is to discuss: (1) recreational measures for fishing year 2019 for Gulf of Maine cod, Gulf of Maine haddock, and Georges Bank cod, (2) Council priorities for 2019, (3) planning for public listening sessions for a possible limited access program for the recreational groundfish party and charter fishery, and (4) other business as necessary.

Recreational Management Measures for Fishing Year 2019

NEFSC staff will provide an overview of recent recreational catch and effort data for Gulf of Maine cod, Gulf of Maine haddock, and Georges Bank cod. Staff will also provide results from the bioeconomic model for Gulf of Maine cod and Gulf of Maine (Doc. 3). NEFSC and GARFO staff will answer questions from the advisors. Council staff will provide an overview of the Groundfish Plan Development Team discussion (Docs. 2 and 5b). The advisors may wish to develop recommendations to the Groundfish Committee on the recreational management measures for fishing year 2019 for Gulf of Maine cod, Gulf of Maine haddock, and Georges Bank cod.

Council staff will provide an overview of Marine Recreational Information Program (MRIP) allocation of sampling by wave, and available for-hire vessel trip report data on effort and landings by wave (Doc. 2).

<u>Council's Public Listening Sessions on the Possibility of Limited Entry in the Recreational</u> <u>Groundfish Party and Charter Fishery</u>
