Next Steps

The Groundfish Committee will meet on Jan. 26, 2021 to take up these meeting topics followed by the Council meeting on the same day. The Council will take final action on FW61, make recommendations to GARFO on FY2021 recreational measures, and discuss next steps for possible limited entry in the party/charter recreational groundfish fishery.
