**SUBJECT:** Purpose and agenda for meeting

The Ecosystem Based Fishery Management (EBFM) Plan Development Team (PDT) will meet by webinar beginning at 9:00 am on February 1, 2023. The meeting will break for lunch and at other times, as needed.

<u>Purpose</u>: This meeting will review progress and technical details of a Prototype Management Strategy Evaluation (pMSE) based on the ceilings and floors catch management approach in the example Fishery Ecosystem Plan (eFEP). The pMSE is being led and conducted by Dr. Gavin Fay and Dr. Lisa Kerr. Technical guidance and feedback from the PDT is expected and will be incorporated into future work. Guidance from the PDT is expected on:

- Primary and secondary metrics
- Management procedures and alternatives with values for parameters specified/suggested
- A refined list of OM scenarios

The Council is conducting a pMSE to develop the tools conduct a full stakeholder-engaged MSE in 2023 and understand the gaps in information and analyses that will be needed. Summaries of pMSE stakeholder meetings are available on the <a href="Council">Council</a>'s <a href="EBFM">EBFM</a> page</a>. A draft summary of the January 6 stakeholder workshop will be distributed with the package of PDT meeting materials. In addition, the Council is currently conducting <a href="Seven Public Information Workshops">Seven Public Information Workshops</a> to engage with stakeholders about eFEP and potential EBFM strategies, using the communication tools that were developed by Greenfin Studio and reviewed by the PDT.
