SUBJECT: Remand of an ABC to the Scientific and Statistical Committee

At its November 18th meeting, the Groundfish Committee passed the following motion:

The Groundfish Committee recommends to the Council a preliminary ABC for witch flounder of 394 mt (with associated ACL and sub-ACLs) described in Table 10, Option 2 (Revised ACLs in Draft FW55 Alternatives, November 10, 2015). The Committee further recommends that the Council request that the SSC reconsider the ABC taking into consideration the incidental, non-target catch of witch flounder under the current prevailing operating conditions of the fishery.

The motion carried 11/0/0.

Council members seeking to remand ABC recommendations back to the SSC should be aware that the Council has a policy in place for remanding recommendations back to the SSC and should be prepared to explain which of the four criteria that justify a remand are met.

Council Remands to the SSC The Council may remand back to its Scientific and Statistical Committee the SSC's recommendations based on the following criteria: (a) failure of the committee to follow the terms of reference provided to it by the Council; (b) an error, in fact or omission, in the materials provided to the committee; (c) an error in fact in the calculations, if any, undertaken by the Committee in developing an ABC recommendation; and (d) failure of the committee to follow its standard operating procedures.
