- Review draft analyses provided by Council contractors on recruitment assumptions used in stock projections for white hake and comment on their utility when modifying the rebuilding plan and setting specifications.

- Any other business, including brief updates on:
 - Identifying SSC members to serve as discussion leads for developing ABC recommendations.

 - o Commenting on updating National Standards 4, 8, and 9 Guidelines.
