TO:Council MembersFROM:Tom Nies, Executive DirectorSUBJECT:Background Northeast Multispecies (Groundfish) Default Specifications

Default specifications were established through Framework Adjustment 53 (FW53) and became effective May 1, 2015. The Council's proposal (approved by NMFS) was 35% of the previous year's specifications and only in place for the first three months (May 1 to July 31) of the incoming fishing year. The default specifications can also be reduced if they exceed the Council's recommendations. The Council selected from a range of No Action and 10%, 20% or 35% of the previous year's specifications and only in place for the first three months.

The regulations read: $\S648.90(a)(3)$ Default OFLs, ABCs, and ACLs.

(i) Unless otherwise specified in this paragraph (a)(3), if final specifications are not published in the Federal Register for the start of a fishing year, as outlined in paragraph (a)(4) of this section, specifications for that fishing year shall be set at 35 percent of the previous year's specifications for each NE multispecies stock, including the U.S./Canada shared resources, for the period of time beginning on May 1 and ending on July 31, unless superseded by the final rule implementing the current year's specifications.

(ii) If the default specifications exceed the Council's recommendations for any stock for the current year, the specifications for that stock shall be reduced to the Council's recommendation through notice consistent with the Administrative Procedure Act.

(iii) These specifications shall be subdivided among the various sub-components of the fishery consistent with the ABC/ACL distribution adopted for the previous year's specifications
