Scallop Committee

I. STATUS

- A. <u>Meetings</u>: There was a joint Scallop PDT/AP meeting on May 4 and a Scallop PDT conference call on May 22. The Scallop AP met on May 31, which was followed by a Scallop Committee meeting on June 1 (both in Boston, MA).
- B. <u>LAGC IFQ Program Review Report:</u> Consistent with MSA requirements, the Council has completed a draft program review for the LAGC IFQ fishery (2010 2015). Staff will be presenting findings from the LAGC IFQ five-year performance review.
- C. <u>RSA Priorities Discussion:</u> At least bi-annually, the Council recommends scallop RSA research priorities. The Council will be considering the Committee's recommendations; final recommendations as approved by the Council will be forwarded to the NEFSC for inclusion in the federal funding opportunity announcement later this summer.
- D. Framework Adjustment 29 (specifications and management measures): This action would consider measures that modify the NGOM management area. In addition to NGOM measures, this action will include: scallop fishery specifications for FY2018 and default measures for FY2019 (ABC/ACLs, DAS, access area allocations for LA and LAGC, hard-TAC for NGOM management area, target-TAC for LAGC incidental catch and set-asides for the observer and research programs), as well as flatfish accountability measures. This action may also include a suite of management measures which reflect the Council's 2017 scallop priorities.
- E. <u>Control Date</u>. The Council will be considering a motion from the March 30, 2017 Committee meeting to establish a control date that could be used to address movement between LAGC permit categories (ex: annually move between a category B Northern Gulf of Maine permit and a category C incidental permit).
