Enforcement

December 2025 – Present

- **Fishing Vessel Boardings – 50**
- **Fishery Violations Issued – 13**
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 90%**

Safety

December 2025 – Present

- **Dockside Safety Exams Conducted: 54**
CFVS Decals Issued: 52
- **Total Number CFV Safety Boardings: 50**
- **At Sea Total Safety Violations Issued: 8**
 - Onboard 6 individual vessels.
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 88%**

Search and Rescue

- CG responded to 70 F/V Incidents/Casualties
 - 7 Disabled/Adrift/Anchored F/Vs
 - 0 Allisions
 - 2 Vessel Aground/Taking on Water/loss on rocks
 - 11 Lives Saved
- 0 MEDEVAC/MEDICOs
