# Enforcement

05 June 2021 – 17 September 2021

- **Fishing Vessel Boardings: 551**
- **Fishery Violations Issued: 38**
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 93%**

# Safety

05 June 2021 – 17 September 2021



- **Dockside Safety Exams: 412**
- **CFVS Decals Issued: 328**
- **CFV Boardings: 347**
  
- **At Sea Safety Violations: 158**
  - **Onboard 81 individual vessels.**
  - **13 safety violation terminations.**
  
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 77%**

# Search and Rescue

05 June 2021 – 17 September 2021



- **CG responded to 33 CFV Incidents/Casualties**
  - 14 Equipment Casualties
  - 6 Taking on Water (Did Not Sink)
  - 6 Collisions/Allisions
  - 4 Vessel Sinkings (2 u/w, 2 @ Mooring/Pier)
  - 2 Crew Conflicts
  - Total: 135+ Fishermen assisted
- **15 MEDEVAC/MEDICOs**
  - Total: 135+ Fishermen assisted
  - 3 Deaths, 2 Fishing Related / 1 Non-Fishing
