Enforcement

18 September 2021 – 22 November 2021

- **Fishing Vessel Boardings: 296**
- **Fishery Violations Issued: 11**
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 96%**

Safety

18 September 2021 – 22 November 2021



- **Dockside Safety Exams Conducted: 87**
CFVS Decals Issued: 72
- **Total Number of CFV Boardings: 205**
- **At Sea Total Safety Violations Issued: 63**
 - **Onboard 35 individual vessels.**
 - **8 terminations this period due to safety violations.**
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 83%**

Search and Rescue

18 September 2021 – 22 November 2021



- **CG responded to 19 F/V Incidents/Casualties**
 - **10 Equipment Casualties**
 - **2 F/Vs taking on water (Did Not Sink)**
 - **1 Groundings**
 - **3 Collisions/Allisions**
 - **3 Vessel Sinkings** (1 Underway / 2 on Mooring/Pier)
 - **41+ Fishermen assisted**
- **0 MEDEVAC/MEDICOs**
- **1 Deaths – 1 Fishing Related / 0 Non-Fishing**
