# **Herring Committee**

#### I. STATUS

### A. Meetings:

- On December 10, 2015, the Herring Plan Development Team (PDT) met to discuss 2016 Council priorities for Atlantic herring, review scoping comments and develop information and analyses for Amendment 8 to the Atlantic Herring FMP, discuss the potential for using state port-side monitoring data to monitor the river herring/shad (RH/S) catch caps, review/discuss development of industry-funded monitoring options for the Atlantic herring fishery in the omnibus IFM amendment, and develop recommendations for 2017-2022 research priorities for Atlantic herring.
- On January 12, 2016, the Herring Advisory Panel (AP) met to review Amendment 8 scoping comments and provide recommendations to the Herring Committee on the development of this action. This included discussion of a potential management strategy evaluation of the herring acceptable biological catch (ABC) control rule. In addition, the AP developed recommendations for RH/S catch cap monitoring, research priorities, and the Georges Bank haddock accountability measure.
- On January 13, 2016, the Herring Committee met to review the AP recommendations, discuss all topics considered by the AP, and develop PDT tasks and recommendations for the Council.
- On January 21, 2016, the Herring PDT met to discuss AP and Committee meeting outcomes, PDT tasks, and work planning, pending further direction from the January Council meeting.
- B. <u>2016-2018 Atlantic Herring Specifications</u>: The preliminary submission to NMFS was on November 4, 2015. The Council took final action in September 2015.

## II. COUNCIL ACTION

- A. Consider the Committee recommendation to develop a Management Strategy Evaluation of the Atlantic Herring ABC control rule for Amendment 8.
- B. Consider the Committee recommendation to support the motion postponed from the September 2015 Council meeting regarding the request to use state portside data to monitor river herring/shad catch caps, with the inclusion of using the data to monitor the haddock catch caps.
