- B. 2016-2018 Atlantic Herring Specifications: The proposed rule has not been published yet.
- C. <u>Industry Funded Monitoring Amendment:</u> The IFM PDT is working on completing the DEIS for public hearings scheduled for October.
- D. <u>Amendment 8:</u> Analyses have begun on alternative acceptable biological catch (ABC) control rules recommended through the MSE process and a second workshop is being planned for December 2016; the Committee has begun work on identifying a range of alternatives to address localized depletion.
- E. <u>Framework 5:</u> The Herring PDT is developing analyses to support development of alternative accountability measures (AMs) for the GB haddock sub-ACL allocated to the midwater trawl herring fishery.
