# Why have guidelines?

- •SAW WGs mostly ad hoc in nature, with membership often left to chance.
  - Group sizes often too large or small
  - Too many or too few experts on particular topics
  - Strive to be inclusive while addressing independence and advocacy
  - Progress and Decision Making by SAW WGs
- NRCC recommended developing SAW WG guidelines on:
  - expertise
  - composition/balance
  - size

#### **Background and Recent Actions**

- •The NRCC formed a WG to craft the guidelines (2013).
- •NRCC WG comprised of NEFMC, MAFMC, ASMFC, NEFSC staff
- •NRCC reviewed drafts of the report in 2009, 2013, and 2014.
- •Guidelines have been developed.

  We expect them to evolve over time.

### SAW WG: Eligibility and Selection Guidelines

- Eligibility criteria
  - Independence
  - Expertise
- WG composition and size
  - Balance of Expertise
  - 4 8 members
  - Invited collaborators allowed
- Selection
  - Initial list
  - Final approval by NRCC committee
