




## The Maritime Boundary – Three Parts


United States and The Bahamas



- 1. The Straits of Florida:
  - Equidistant boundary (split the difference)
- North of the Straits, within the EEZ
  - The U.S. EEZ limit, as published in the U.S.
    Federal Register
- 3. Extended continental shelf (beyond 200 NM)
  - No position
