- Need more quota
- ▶ Reduce the management uncertainty buffer
- ▶ Change the bait skate incidental limit
- Want barndoor skate

Limited Access comments

- Revisit control dates
- Might need incidental permits
- Separate the wing and bait fisheries
- Permit splitting no clear position
- Ownership caps
- Tiered permit structure
- Don't affect current operations
- Don't affect the monkfish fishery
- Consideration for groundfish fishery
- Don't change current management structure

Limited Access comments

- I've had enough
- Don't take our skates
- Can't believe we're discussing limited access for skate
- Concern over qualification
- Concern this would lead to catch shares & consolidation
- Stock status is good why is this needed
- Need to catch more skate because they're highly abundant
- Split the FMP up

AP discussions

- No quorum
- Members present supported
 - Existing control date and limited access for both fisheries
 - Tiered approach and not opposed to applying limited access to one fishery
- No objection to
 - Using historic landings for qualification for wing fishery
 - Using LOA for qualification in the bait fishery

Committee tasking

- Dividing the two skate fisheries for independent limited access programs
- Review on justification for limited access for each fishery
- Analyze different possession limits for day and trip boats in wing fishery

Upcoming Specifications Framework

- Specifications
 - Updated survey indices expected in summer
- Landing of barndoor skate
 - PDT needs to know what is best for industry
 - Separate barndoor skate trip limits
 - Year round fishery
 - PDT may come up with additional options depending on biological considerations
 - PDT will have to work on discard estimation
- Other consideration
 - Possession limits for FY2017
