Commercial eVTR Framework

- Proposed action: require commercial vessels with federal permits issued by GARFO to submit VTRs electronically, unify VTR submission timelines
- Goal: Reduce reporting burden/redundancies of paper VTR, improve reporting efficiency, decrease error
- Note: No changes are proposed for the data types being collected.

Affected Permit Holders

- Vessels with Federal commercial permits for species managed by the MAFMC and NEFMC (see Table 1).
- Total of 2,929 permits holders

Does **NOT** apply to:

- American lobster-only permit holders (i.e. no VTR requirement)
- NEFMC party/charter—will be addressed in future action (TBD)

- Dec 2018: MAFMC initiated action

- Sep 2019: NEFMC FW meeting I, approve range of alternatives
 - Consider alternatives to change the VTR submission deadline (24hrs, 48hrs, 72hrs, weekly)

- Spring 2020 Summer 2020: outreach & training workshops
- Extended implementation following final rule (up to ~I yr.)

Current VTR Requirements

- A VTR is required for any trip on a GARFO permitted vessel when you catch fish or when your operations include activities that would support fishing
- A separate VTR page is needed each time a vessels changes gear type, mesh size or chart area
- Vessels with multiple permits are held to the most restrictive requirements
- eVTR has been authorized for all Northeast Region federally permitted vessels since 2013
