 SSC meeting on March 26 covered a couple topics but this presentation will only cover SSC comments on State of the Ecosystem Report



#### Terms of Reference

 The SSC will receive a presentation on the Northeast Fisheries Science Center's Ecosystems Status Report and provide the Council any recommendations about possible revisions to the report for the next year



- SSC was provided a thorough review of the State of the Ecosystem Report (SOE) by Dr Sean Lucey
- SSC appreciated the new structure and again thanked NEFSC for such a useful and quality product
  - Positive evolution of the report since its inception was appreciated by the group
- SSC made several editorial comments;
  subsequently provided to NEFSC directly

- SSC offered the following suggestions for consideration as modifications to the report:
  - Ocean acidification is a factor contained in the MAFMC report and could be considered as an addition to the New England version of the report as well
  - There was discussion on trends presented in the report, with a note that long term trends would be more valuable if shorter term trends were also presented for context

- SSC offered the following suggestions for consideration as modifications to the report:
  - General appreciation for socio-economic information contained in the report; SSC felt there was more scope to broaden this information even further
    - Expansion of the subset of the information on the spatial nature of socio-cultural information
    - More focus on commercial revenues than commercial profits would be beneficial



- SSC offered the following suggestions for consideration as modifications to the report:
  - SSC stated that offering management objectives up front in the report was a way to provide context for the overall report



- Some discussion on how the information could be incorporated into stock assessments:
  - A more directed subject specific series of reports is being developed for this purpose;
     NEFSC also recognizes the need to provide the information in a way that can be integrated into the quantitative processes for fish stocks
  - They are working towards this product in parallel with the SOE
