All modes – private and for-hire:

o Open Season: September 15-30 and April 1-14

o Bag Limit: 1 fish

o Minimum Size: 21 inches

To add two weeks to the September season for party/charter open for September 8-14 and October 1-7 (i.e., open September 8-October 7) for FY2020 only.
