NEW ENGLAND FISHERY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL Scientific and Statistical Committee (SSC)

I. STATUS

Meetings:

The SSC met on October 12-14 in Providence, RI. The committee received reports on the Operational Stock Assessments for Groundfish (NE Multispecies), and assessment updates for Atlantic scallops and red hake as well as plan development team analyses about ABC alternatives for these stocks. The committee developed OFL and ABC recommendations for groundfish stocks for fishing years 2016-2018, for Atlantic scallops for fishing years 2016 and 2017 (default) and for red hake for fishing years 2016 and 2017.

II. COUNCIL ACTION

No action is required as a part of this agenda item, but the Council will consider the SSC's recommendations in selecting a preferred alternative for OFLs ABCs for groundfish and scallops under separate agenda items. (The Council already identified a preferred alternative for the OFL and ABC for red hake at the September meeting contingent upon SSC agreement.)
